Gothic Quarter, Barcelona

Barcelona's Gothic Quarter contains Roman ruins, gothic architecture and plenty of shopping and local delicacies. Make sure you visit the cathedral and the winding and narrow streets around it.

Port Aventura, Barcelona

Spend a full day of thrills at Port Aventura theme park with rides, live entertainment and other amusements—what's not to like? This is sure to be a hit with your students.

Boat Tour, Barcelona

Take to the water on a sightseeing boat tour of the port of Barcelona and experience the Catalan capital from a new perspective. The tour lasts around 60 minutes.

Picasso Museum, Barcelona

The Museum in Barcelona has a staggering 4,250 pieces. Although Picasso was born in Malagá, he considered Barcelona and Catalonia his true home & heavily influenced his work.

Bosc Urbà, Barcelona

Experience the first adventure park in the city. Ziplines, climbing forest networks, bungee jumping and bridges are just some of the attractions awaiting your group!

Montjuïc Cable Car, Barcelona

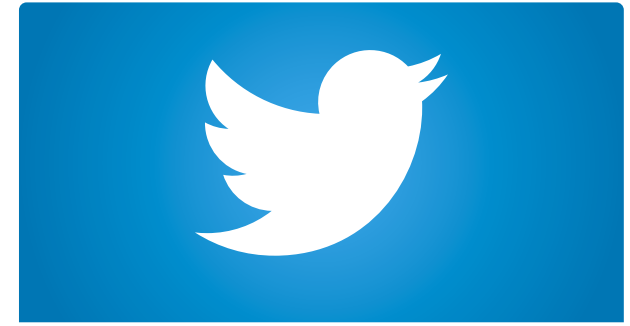
